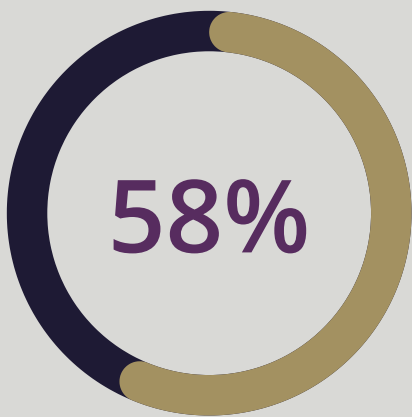


# CPA UK and Pakistan WPC Workshop May 2021

- Parliamentary codes of conduct and ending harassment in the workplace

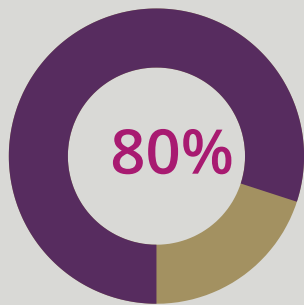

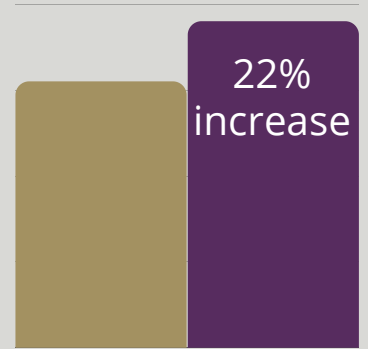

The increase of knowledge is based on self-ratings from the delegates before and after the workshop.

80% of participants said the workshop was 'fully relevant' to their role



Average increase in learning overall was by 22%



The largest increase in learning was for 'Planning for a committee inquiry' with an increase of 47%
